INVITATION AND ANNOUNCEMENT

It is with great pleasure that Djurgårdens IF Konståkning invites you to participate in DIF Trophy 2026, an Interclub competition in figure skating.

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and the Swedish Figure Skating Association (Svenska Konståkningsförbundet), including relevant ISU Communications and Swedish competition regulations.

1. GENERAL

DIF Trophy 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution 2025, Competition & Event Regulations 2026, Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, and the relevant ISU Communications. DIF Trophy is open to skaters from figure skating clubs affiliated with the Swedish Figure Skating Association and, where applicable, clubs and federations associated with the ISU..

The competition will be organized by Djurgårdens IF Konståkning. Detailed information regarding the competition, schedule, entries and practical arrangements will be communicated to participating clubs.

5. MUSIC

Music will be played from digital mp3 files. Music shall be uploaded in accordance with the instructions provided via registration form. Each skater is also responsible for bringing an i-pod or telephone as backup to the competition. The file name must clearly state full name of the competitor, program, country, name of club and the category in which the skater is entered.

Swedish participants should upload their music in SportTA, as usual.

6. DRAW

The opening draw will be at Husby Ishall. In the free skating the skaters will skate in reversed result order of the short program.

7. RESULTS

Information regarding the draw, start orders and results will be published through the competition's official result page and/or communicated to participating clubs.

8. TRANSPORTATION

Participants are responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from Stockholm. Further information about public transport, parking and local transportation will be provided closer to the event.

From Official hotel to Husby Ishall

From Kista Galleria, take the blue line of the Stockholm Metro (T-bana) towards Akalla from Kista station. Travel one stop to Husby. From Husby station, follow the signs towards Husby ishäll. The arena is approximately 600 metres from the metro station, a walk of around 8 minutes.

9. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation for event officials, judges, team leaders, competitors and coaches will take place at the competition venue. Exact opening times will be communicated in the final event information.

10. OFFICIAL HOTEL

The organizer is working with the selected hotel in Stockholm.

Award ceremonies will take place off ice during the next ice resurfacing break following the completion of each class.

Skaters are kindly asked to be ready for the award ceremony immediately after their class has finished.

13. LIABILITY

In accordance with applicable ISU and Swedish Figure Skating Association regulations, the Organizing Committee accepts no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for loss of or damage to property incurred by competitors, officials, coaches or other participants. Each participating club is responsible for ensuring that its participants have appropriate insurance coverage.

The organizer will provide appropriate emergency and first-aid arrangements at the competition venue during the event.
